



Orfe Camps Information package

Where is Orfe Camps located? Our Camp take place at 1300 Leslie Street, North York, ON. St. Bonaventure Parish Centre facilities.

How will my camper spend his / her Camp Day? The children spend their time making Eco-Art and fun activities during the day. They learn to prepare the necessary elements for each artistic project by recycling. Orfe Team will guide them through each topic with creative art jobs that will be used during the camp and doing role plays. They will play outdoors during the lunch break (weather permitting).

What are the Camp's check in and check-out times? Regular check-in time is between 8:50 and 9 a.m. Regular pick-up time is at 3:40 p.m. The first day of camp, please arrive by 8:45 a.m. or earlier if you have questions.

Extended Care: This is not available currently.

Where should I park? There is a parking lot behind of the Parish Center

What should I do if my camper is going to be absent? If your camper cannot attend, please contact us at 647 6255459 or email before 8:45 a.m. to report the absence.

What are the cancellation and refund policies?

10% fee when you cancel more than a month before program start date.

15 % fee when you cancel between 2 weeks before program start date.

There won't be refund if:

- The camper is absent and missed days cannot be made up.
- You decide to withdraw your registration within a week before program start date.
- The student does not continue in the program for any reason
- Orfe decides that the student should not continue, because of force majeure or exceptional circumstances, including bad and/or aggressive behaviour. Orfe does not tolerate bullying.
- There is a class cancellation due to an extenuating circumstance, such as extreme weather conditions, power failures, school closures, strikes, any life-threatening situation, or other circumstances beyond our control.

What should my camper wear to Camp? Campers must be dressed comfortably and appropriately, based on the weather. **Open-toe shoes, roller shoes and Crocs are not considered safe for Camp.**

What should my camper bring to Camp? Your camper's backpack should contain the following items:

1. A water bottle
2. Lunch
3. Two snacks & three drinks
4. Summertime: Sunscreen and insect repellent (to be self-applied), and a hat
7. Wintertime: Winter clothing for outdoor activities
8. We will work with a lot of non-toxic acrylics that could stain certain fabrics, so please send an apron and/or **old clothes to use in class.**

Campers should not bring personal items such as iPods, electronic games, cellular phones, toys, sport equipment or anything of personal value to Camp. There are no lockers available for storage and the Orfe cannot be held responsible for lost or damaged goods.

What happens to lost items? Any lost items will be placed in the Camp's lost and found, located in the classroom. We cannot hold any unclaimed items for more than 1 week.

What will my camper eat at Camp? Campers should bring two snacks, three drinks, and a packed lunch with them each day for full day Camp. Please note that refrigeration for lunches and snacks is not available to campers. Campers will also not have access to microwaves or vending machines. We encourage litter-less lunches.

Nut Policy

Some of the children attending Orfe Eco-Art camps may have food allergies. We kindly ask to not send with your child food that contain such products. Please advise your children to not sharing their food with other students.

Orfe programs do not offer or guarantee a nut-free environment. If your children have any nut or related allergies, please let us know when registering. Make sure that your child has an individual emergency plan, including an epinephrine injector (Epi-Pen) if needed.

What about camper care? Orfe Camp programs are delivered by responsible, enthusiastic and caring staff with experience working with children in an educational and / or recreational environment and have Vulnerable Sector Screening Checks.

Can visitors access Camp rooms and / or join in Camp activities? Visitors or camper parents / guardians are not permitted to enter Camp rooms or to join in Camp activities

What about health and safety? Please complete the Medical / Special Needs Form if you have information you need to provide us about your camper(s).

If your camper must take medication during their Camp Day, please let us know to discuss options. While we will do our best to remind campers of their medications, we cannot guarantee this. After-Bite or similar sting itch relief product may be administered if necessary.

For the health and safety of your child (ren) and because campers' activities take place throughout the Orfe facilities, we require camper(s) with EpiPens® to always carry them while at Camp.

What if my camper has special needs? In case you indicated your camper's special need(s) or medical information on his/ her Medical / Special Needs form, we may be in touch with you prior to your Camp week for more information. We regret that we cannot provide one on-one supervision or specific medical support, but campers with special needs may have an adult support person accompany them (Fee may be charged).

How is my camper expected to behave at Camp? We expected that campers will respect each other, their teachers, staff, and their environment while at Camp. It is also expected that no camper will exhibit behaviour that is harmful to them self or anyone else. If a camper does not adhere to our Camper Code of Conduct or behaves in an unsuitable / unsafe manner, the registering Parent / guardian will be notified. Violent behavior will not be tolerated and will result in termination of the enrollment.

Camper Code of Conduct:

- Respect all the participant of the camp, volunteers, staff and other visitors.
- Treat everybody the way I would like to be treated.
- Cooperate with camp staff and follow their instructions.
- Stay with my group, unless I have special permission not to be with them.
- Use equipment and supplies adequately.
